- > misinformation (false, out-of-date, inaccurate, incomplete)
- malinformation (potentially dangerous or damaging information, inappropriate information)
- messed up information (poorly organized & presented)
- > useless information (though one man's trash may be another person's treasure)

## **First steps**

- ➤ Know what you already know
- ➤ Know what you are looking for
- > Know what what-you-are-looking-for looks like
- ➤ Know where to look
- **≻Know how to look**


## Of search engines & directories

- > internet tools to help you locate information
- > search engines are automated; directories are driven by humans
- > results will vary according to which search engine you use and how effectively you use it
- > different search engines use different techniques to locate information
- > search engines do not have access to every web page in the world – perhaps 0.002% of web pages worldwide can be found through searches

- > Address / URL




